

THE DAILY URBAN EXPERIENCE: MOBILITY AND EMOTIONS SENSING

This study is being conducted by the Technical University of Denmark, the Faculty of Medicine (FMUL), the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning (IGOT) and NeuroGEARS Ltd.

The study will **explore the relationship between the daily mobility and activity decisions, the emotions, and the urban environment**. The volunteers are invited to participate in order to help a better understanding on how to create urban public spaces that promote health and well-being for all.

Participants will wear a wristband (like a smartwatch) to measure physiological signals (such as heart rate and skin temperature) and use a free mobile app to **record travel and activities and report their emotions for 14 days**.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

Any person 18 years or older living in the Greater Copenhagen (Denmark) area can participate.

To ensure that the physiological measures reflect individuals' emotional level, participants may not suffer from any severe health condition (e.g. cardiovascular problems, severe mental illness) or be pregnant during the data collection.

The screening survey is designed to check whether you are eligible or not to participate in our study.
